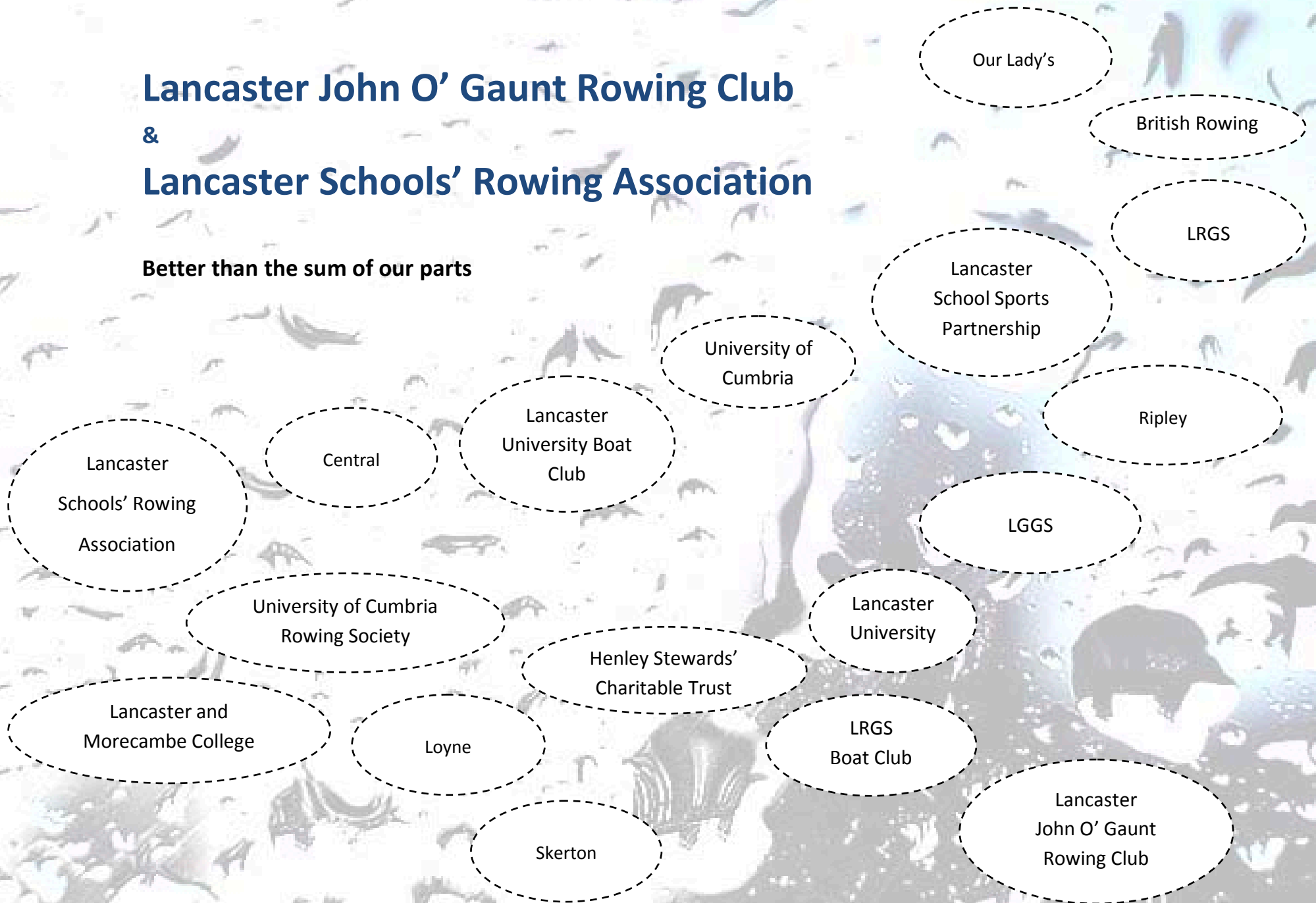


Lancaster John O' Gaunt Rowing Club & Lancaster Schools' Rowing Association

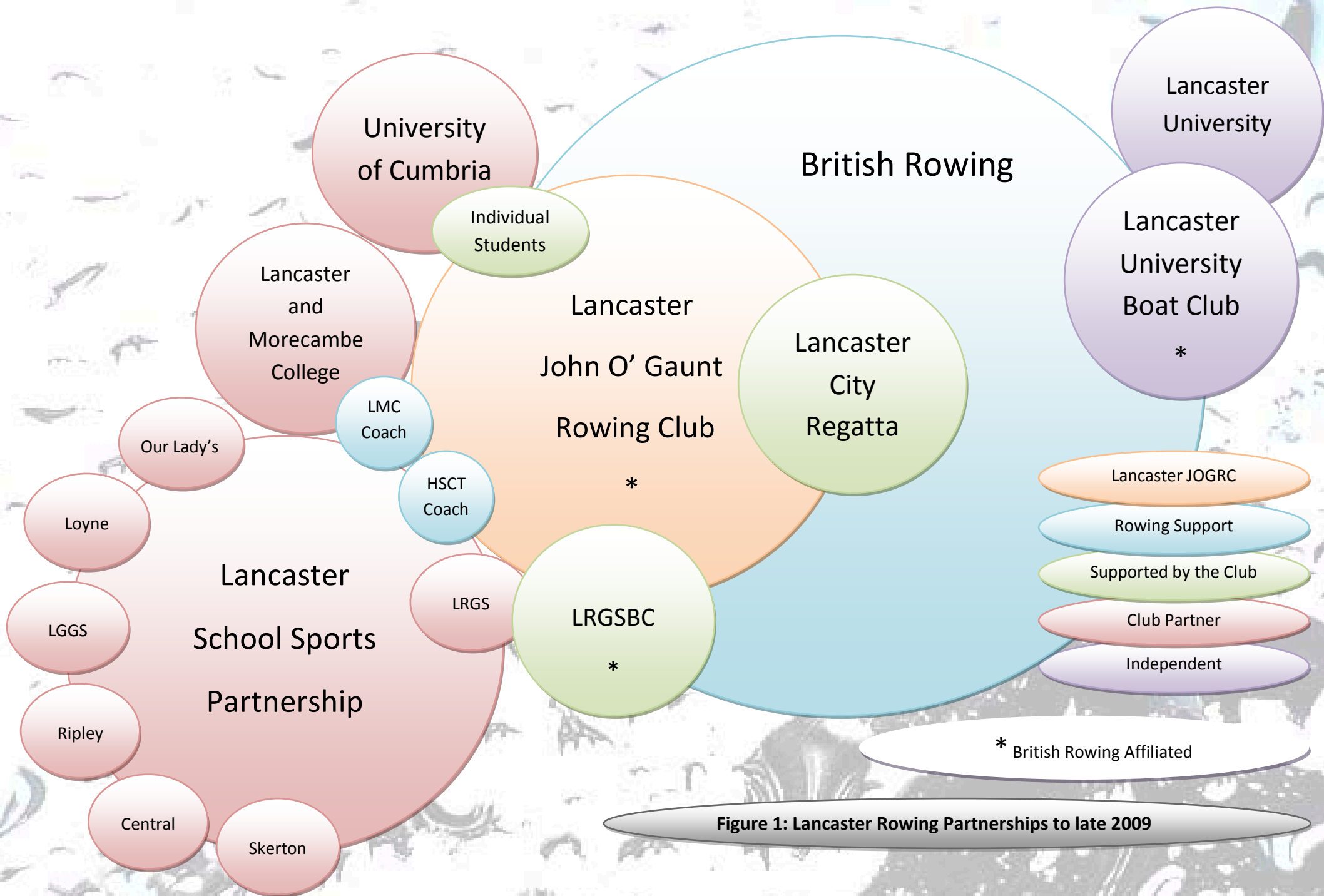


Figure 1: Lancaster Rowing Partnerships to late 2009

Rowing in Lancaster to late 2009 *(see figure 1)*

To date, rowing in Lancaster has been delivered by three clubs - Lancaster John O' Gaunt Rowing Club (Skerton), Lancaster Royal Grammar School Boat Club (Skerton) and Lancaster University Boat Club (Halton). Lancaster University Boat Club is independent of the other two clubs.

Recent Developments

British Rowing advised Lancaster John O' Gaunt Rowing Club and the Lancaster Schools Sport Partnership to set up the Lancaster Schools' Rowing Association; this follows the work of Amy Ward (Henley Stewards' funded coach).

Lancaster John O' Gaunt Rowing Club started to recruit students from the University of Cumbria.

Lancaster and Morecambe College provided a free coach to aid the Henley Stewards' funded coach.

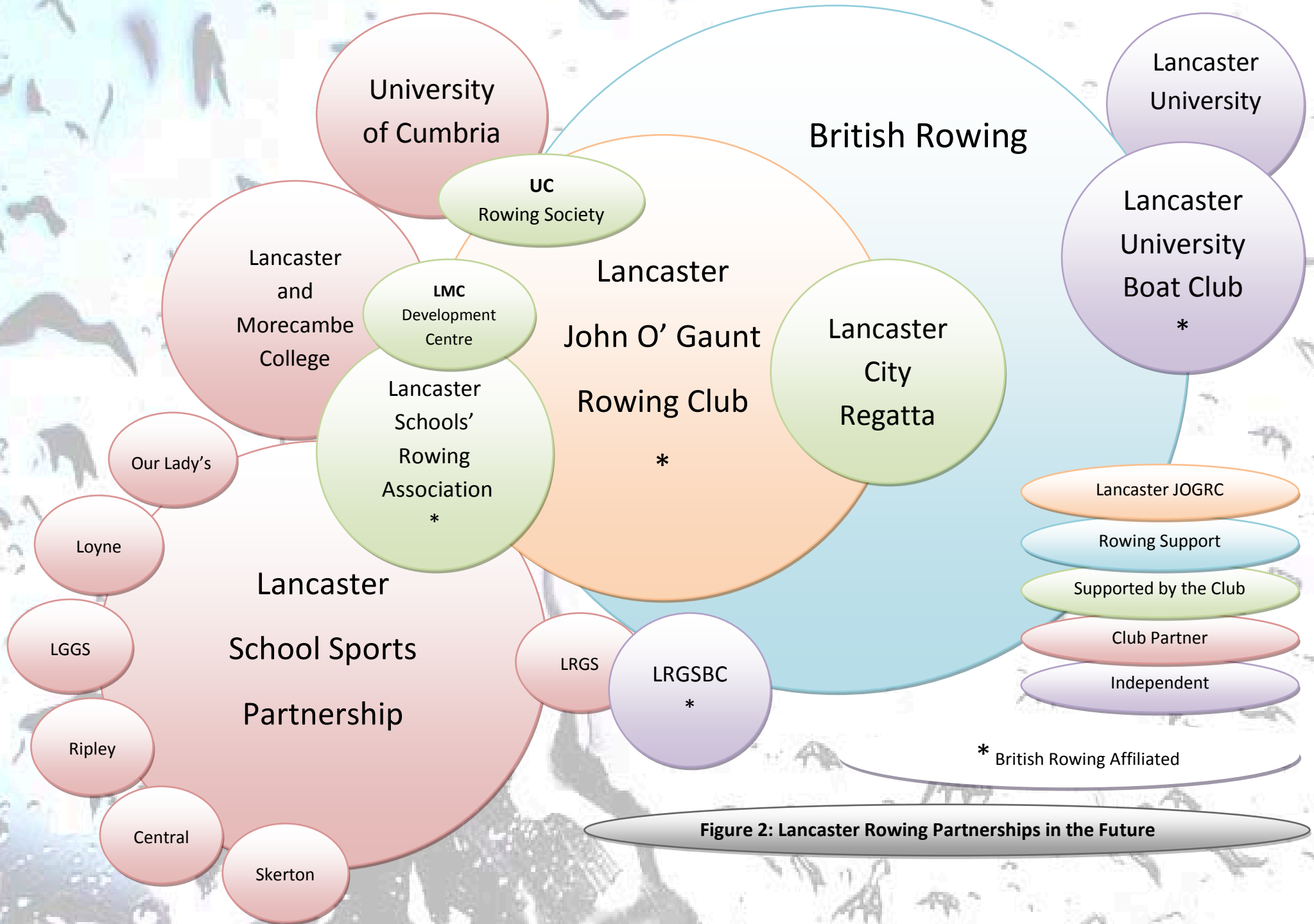


Figure 2: Lancaster Rowing Partnerships in the Future

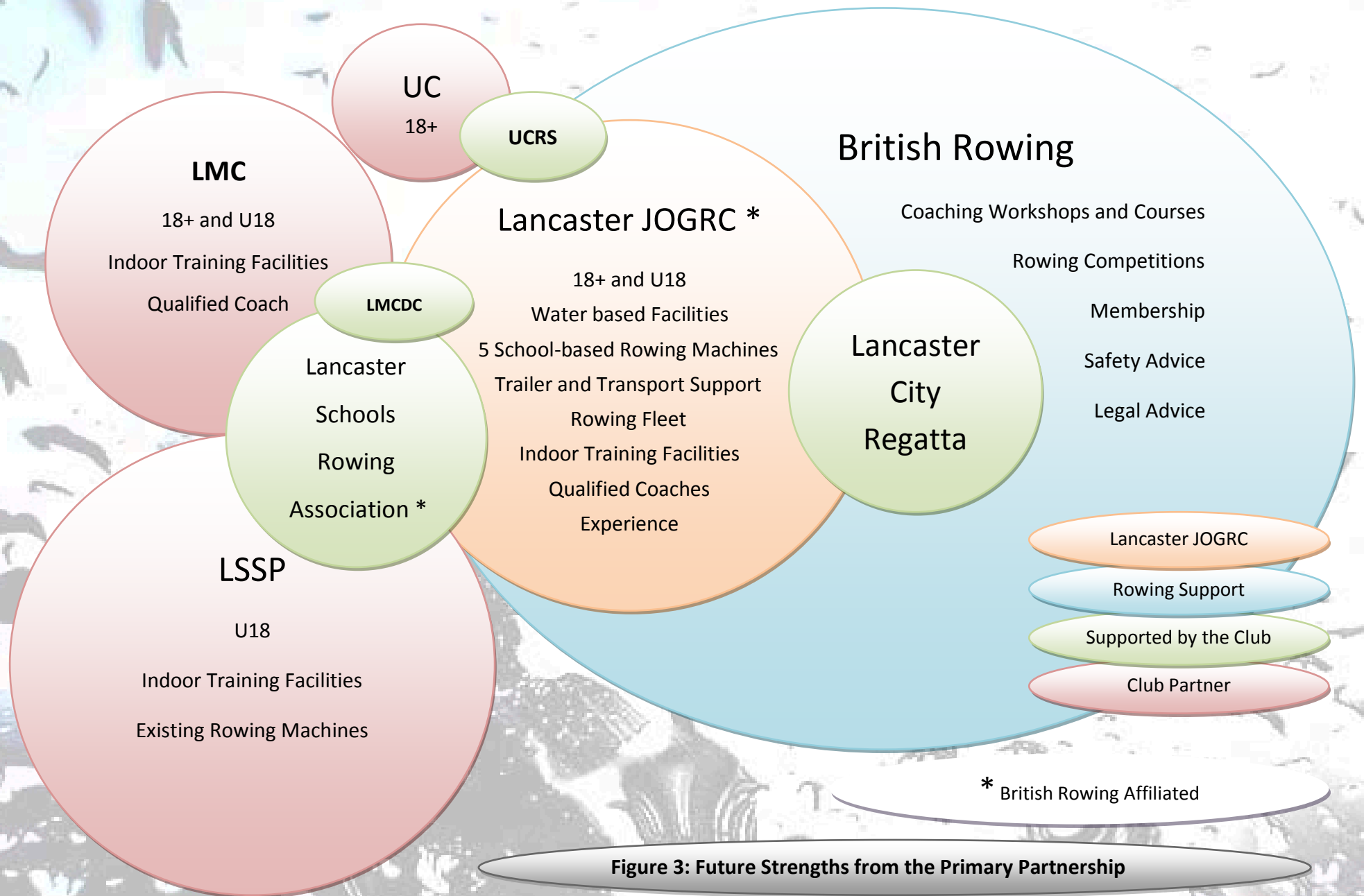


Figure 3: Future Strengths from the Primary Partnership

A Future Model for Rowing in Lancaster *(see figure 2 and figure 3)*

The newly founded Lancaster Schools' Rowing Association will be established to coordinate junior rowing in Lancaster.

Lancaster Royal Grammar School's existing lease ends in March 2011; the school has indicated that they will exist the building to maintain their independence.

Lancaster and Morecambe College has been designated as one of ten FE colleges to link with a local rowing club, a development centre will follow.

The Club will hope to expand the student base at the University of Cumbria through a Rowing Society.
